Crisp, dry and freshly fruity Loire white, matured on its sediment (Sur Lie) for extra richness of flavour.
112. **2006 Rioja Blanco, Vina Ijalba – Spain** 19.50
Beautifully clean and fresh, a modern style Rioja.
113. **2002 Bourgogne Aligote, Domaine Felix et Fils – Cote d' Auxerre** 22.00
The Aligote grape makes a pretty golden colour with greenish hints. The nose is pure and clean, whilst the taste is vivacious with a mellowness of apple and grapefruit. Very pleasant and fresh.
114. **2006 Simonsig Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch – South Africa** 24.50
A bright straw colour, with an aromatic nose of pear, apples and a touch of honey. The palate is filled with fruit salad flavours and rich aftertaste. This Chenin reflects the sunny summers the Cape enjoys.
115. **2005 Petit Chablis, Collet and Fils – Burgundy** 28.00
A good clean Petit Chablis. Mineral nose mixed with dry fruits, give mouth puckering acidity with a good length and finish.
116. **2005 Pouilly Fume Curvee de Boisfleury, Domaine A. Cailbourdin – Loire** 31.00
Elegant and complex dry white from this famous Loire appellation with a tangy fruitiness and a hint of smokiness.

A steely Chablis. The nose is of rich ripe fruit, with good maturity, very dry the mineral and flint being excellently developed by the soft acidity. Well balanced, long finish.

Pelle's wines are truly sensational and grace many of the finest wine lists of the world. A near neighbour Sancerre and Pouilly Fume, this rivals anything you can find from these more famous regions.

Award winning wine, full of ripe fruit flavours and added concentration. Cederberg is a rising star in South Africa, with a reputation for making cool climate wines from the countries highest altitude vineyards.
133. **2003/05 Semillon, Ch Tours Des Gendres, Cuvee de Conti – Bergerac** 21.00
Undoubtedly the top estate in Bergerac. Luc Conti has produced another marvellously intense, stylish wine.

Situated close to the famous cloudy bay vineyards, this has textbook gooseberry fruit flavours and a terrific zingy freshness.

139. **2004/05 Gewurztraminer, Dopff Au Moulin – Alsace** 28.00
This is now exhibiting not only spice but also a wonderful fresh floral appeal that goes on and on.
140. **2005 Sauvignon Blanc, Lincoln Estate, Hawkes Bay – New Zealand** 29.00
An impressive vintage meant that the fruit was harvested at the peak of its maturity giving the fruit its characteristics of gooseberries and honeysuckle. The wine has a crisp acidity without being overly dry.
141. **2004 Hollick Riesling, Coonawarra – South Australia** 29.50
This is a surprisingly dry wine made from a sweet grape. It has intense floral and citrus fruit characteristics which are balanced with a cleansing acidic finish.
142. **2003/04 Lirac Cuvee de la Reine des Bois, Mordoree – Rhone** 33.00
Stunning blend of Marsanne and Roussane. A great alternative to Chardonnay based wines, showing similar weight but more exotic, aromatic flavours.

One of the most individual and expressive wines in the world and made in tiny quantities. Gaillard is a top grower who consistently makes benchmark examples of this Viognier based wines.

This has justifiably had praise from many of the famous wine journalists and shows really how Riesling can be perhaps one of the classic noble grape varieties.
